INTERNATIONAL CALL FOR VISITING PROFESSOR/RESEARCHER

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR VISITING PROFESSOR IN BRAZIL 30/07/2024

The President of the Instituto de Medicina Integral Prof. Fernando Figueira - IMIP announces the opening of applications for visiting professor/researcher positions in Health Sciences.

I. PURPOSE

The Visiting Professor Program in Brazil is a strategic initiative to promote and support the internationalization of IMIP's stricto sensu graduate program and aims to:

- 1.1. Attract professors working and residing abroad for research activities and to teach subjects, courses, training, lectures, or seminars in person.
- 1.2. Promote the formation and expansion of international cooperation networks within IMIP's graduate programs.
- 1.3. Stimulate international partnerships to enhance the quality of intellectual production (bibliographic, artistic, and/or technological) and human resource training linked to graduate studies.

II. REQUIREMENTS

2.1. The visiting professor/researcher must hold a doctoral degree and have proven academic teaching experience (at least 3 years of professional teaching) and experience in supervising stricto sensu graduate programs, interdisciplinary research guidance, and relevant scientific production in the health science, with professional activity and residence abroad.

2.2. Submit a Work Plan associated with IMIP's stricto sensu Graduate Program in Integral Health (For more information about the Program, visit the website:

<https://imip.org.br/pos-graduacao-ss/mestrado-e-doutorado-em-saude-integral/> and refer to Annex I).

2.3. Candidates must be prepared to develop research projects and seek international funding, as well as demonstrate interest in long-term collaboration with IMIP.

III. VACANCIES AND CONTRACT PERIOD

3.1. There will be one vacancy per year.

3.2. The contract period for in-person activities in Brazil will last a minimum of 01 (one) month and a maximum of 03 (three) months. The schedule and modality of the activities must be detailed in the work plan submitted by the candidate at the time of registration. Work plans that include remote activities for up to 12 months as a complement to the in-person activities will receive extra points.

IV. BENEFITS

The Visiting Professor Program offers the following benefits to cover the visiting professor's expenses:

4.1. Scholarship proportional to the period of in-person activity in Brazil.

4.2. Travel allowance: round-trip airfare in economy class.

4.3. Health insurance allowance.

4.4. Installation allowance.

The amounts for the scholarship and allowances are detailed in Annex II of this call.

V. APPLICATIONS

Applications for IMIP's Visiting Professor Program in Brazil can be submitted from July 30 to September 23, 2024. Applications must be submitted electronically. To apply, the candidate must follow these steps:

5.1. Fill out the Form: Complete the registration available on the IMIP website: <https://imip.lyceum.com.br/processo-seletivo/home> and upload all the necessary documents listed above.

5.2. Required Documentation:

- Copy of the candidate's Doctoral diploma.
- Copy of the candidate's passport.
- Curriculum Vitae of the candidate and registration on Orcid or an equivalent platform.
- Work plan signed by the candidate.

VI. EXAMINATION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee appointed by the Program's Collegiate is composed of two (02) of its members and one (1) external member.

VII. SELECTION CRITERIA

7.1. The quality and regularity of the candidate's intellectual production (Bibliographic, artistic, and/or technological) will be evaluated through the Curriculum Vitae.

7.2. The quality and consistency of the work plan, with a maximum of 03 (three) pages (in English), will be evaluated and must include research activities, teaching subjects, courses, training, lectures, or seminars in person.

VIII. RESULTS AND ENROLLMENT

8.1. The final result will be published on September 28, 2024, on the IMIP website (www.imip.org.br). Candidates will be evaluated based on the criteria established in this notice. The selected candidate will also be notified by email.

8.2. After the approval announcement, the candidate will have a 15-day period to enroll in the program. The candidate must sign a Commitment Agreement, which must be dated and sent at the beginning of the approved activities in the work plan. This agreement must contain the period of activities and the approved period for the candidate's stay at the Institution. Enrollment in the program will only be effective after the receipt of the duly signed Commitment Agreement (Annex III).

IX. TIMELINE

2. Proposal Submission Period (Application): July 30 to September 18, 2024
3. Final Result: September 28, 2024 (www.imip.org.br)

X. OBLIGATIONS

The Visiting Professor must:

- 10.1. Obtain an entry visa to Brazil with validity compatible with the period of stay in Brazil;
- 10.2. Deliver in-person and virtual lectures/seminars (when applicable to the work plan) on scientific topics related to the research lines of IMIP's Integrated Health Graduate Program;
- 10.3. Develop 2 (two) intellectual production works (original research, review article) in co-authorship with IMIP researchers, making reference to the support provided by IMIP when disclosing, in any means, actions, publications, or results obtained under the auspices of the Institutional Internationalization Project.
- 10.4. Co-develop with an IMIP researcher a research project in English, including a detailed budget, schedule, and submission strategy to funding agencies;
- 10.5. Teach a short course with a workload between 20 and 40 hours, in person at IMIP, on a topic in their field of study;
- 10.6. Submit an activity report developed in Brazil, signed by the Graduate Program Coordinator, within 30 days after the end of activities.

XI. FINAL PROVISIONS

12.1. Failure to comply with any of the requirements specified in this Notice, as judged by the selection committee, will result in the automatic disqualification of the proposal.

12.2. Omissions in this Notice will be decided by the Selection Committee and, if necessary, by the Board of the Integrated Health Graduate Program at IMIP, in accordance with current legislation. This Notice will come into effect on the date of its publication.

ANNEX I - Graduate Program in Integral Health (PPGSI)

The Graduate Program in Integral Health at the Instituto de Medicina Integral Prof. Fernando Figueira (IMIP) offers master's and doctoral degrees, focusing on the training of highly qualified teachers and researchers throughout all stages of the life cycle. The goal is to train professionals for higher education and research, promoting greater scientific productivity in health, with an emphasis on health programs and services, epidemiological, clinical, and translational investigations.

Research Areas:

1. Health Programs and Services:

- o Evaluation of health programs and services.
- o Health professional education.

2. Epidemiological, Clinical, and Surgical Investigation:

- o Epidemiological, clinical, and translational studies in prenatal, childbirth, and postpartum.
- o Clinical and surgical studies in various age groups and specialties, such as urology and gynecology.
- o Prevention of adult diseases in childhood and adolescence..

3. Basic and Translational Research:

- o Biology of aging and cancer: cellular, molecular, genetic, and immunological aspects.
- o Cellular and molecular mechanisms of immunity, inflammation, and infection.

The program aims to train professionals with national and international visibility, capable of leading research groups and significantly contributing to the population's health.
