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The President of the Instituto de Medicina Integral Prof. Fernando Figueira (IMIP) announces the opening of applications for a visiting professor/researcher in Health Sciences

I. PURPOSE

The Visiting Professor Program in Brazil is a strategic initiative to promote and support the internationalization of IMIP's *stricto sensu* graduate program and aims to:

- Attract professors working and residing abroad for research activities and to teach subjects, courses, training, lectures, or seminars in person.
 - 1. Promote the formation and expansion of international cooperation networks within IMIP's graduate programs.
 - 2. Stimulate international partnerships to enhance the quality of intellectual production (bibliographic, artistic, and/or technological) and human resource training linked to graduate studies.

II. REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 The visiting professor/researcher must hold a doctoral degree and have proven academic teaching experience (a minimum of 3 years of professional teaching in higher education) and experience in supervising *stricto sensu* graduate programs, interdisciplinary research guidance, and relevant scientific production in the health area, with professional activity and residence abroad.
- 2.2 Submit a Work Plan in English associated with IMIP's *stricto sensu* Graduate Program in Integral Health. (For more information about the Program, visit the website: https://imip.org.br/pos-graduacao-ss/mestrado-e-doutorado-em-saude-integral/ and refer to Annex I).



2.3 Candidates must be prepared to develop research projects and seek international funding, in addition to demonstrating interest in a long-term collaboration with IMIP.

III. VACANCIES AND CONTRACT PERIOD

- **3.1.** The number of available vacancies is **01 (one) vacancy per year**.
- 3.2 The contract period for **in-person activities in Brazil** will last a **minimum of 01 (one) month and a maximum of 03 (three) months.** The schedule and modality of the activities must be detailed in the work plan submitted by the candidate at the time of registration.

3.2.1. Work Plan Evaluation (up to 6.0 points)

The candidate must submit a detailed work plan at the time of application, containing:

- Schedule of in-person activities.
- Description of the activities to be developed.
- Modality (in-person, remote, or hybrid) of the planned actions.

The work plan will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

Criterion	Maximum Score
Clarity and detail of the schedule and activities	2,0 points
Feasibility of execution in the proposed period	2,0 points
Coherence between objectives, methods, and expected results	2,0 points
Total	6,0 points

3.2.2. Complementary Remote Activities (up to 4.0 points)

Work plans that include **complementary remote activities**, to be developed after the inperson period for **up to 12 (twelve) months**, may receive an additional score of up to 4.0 points, according to the criteria below:

Criterion	Maximum Score
Clarity and detail of the proposed remote activities	1,5 points



Coherence and integration with the in-person activities	1,5 points
Potential contribution to the program/project objectives	1,0 point
Total	4,0 points

- 3.2.3. This extra score will be added to the final grade of the work plan evaluation.
- 3.2.4. The inclusion of remote activities is **optional**, but candidates who choose this modality are recommended to justify its relevance and present monitoring indicators and/or expected results, whenever possible.

IV. BENEFITS

The Visiting Professor Program offers the following benefits intended to cover the visiting professor's expenses:

- Scholarship, proportional to the period of in-person activity development in Brazil.
 - o Monthly payment: R\$ 14,000.00.
- Travel allowance: round-trip airfare, in economy class.
- Health insurance allowance: R\$ 400.00 monthly.
- Installation allowance (One-time payment): R\$ 2,200.00.

V. APPLICATIONS

Applications for IMIP's Visiting Professor Program in Brazil can be submitted from **October 06 to November 12, 2025**. Applications must be submitted electronically.

To apply, the candidate must follow these steps:

- Fill out the Form: Complete the registration available on the IMIP website: https://imip.lyceum.com.br/processo-seletivo/home and upload all the necessary documentation listed below.
- Required Documentation:
 - o Copy of the candidate's doctoral diploma.
 - o Copy of the candidate's passport.



- o Candidate's Curriculum Vitae and registration on Orcid or equivalent platform.
- o Work plan signed by the candidate.

VI. EXAMINATION COMMITTEE

The Examination Committee appointed by the Program's Collegiate is composed of two (02) of its members and one (1) external member to the institution.

VII. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 7.1. The quality and regularity of the candidate's Intellectual Production (Bibliographic, artistic, and/or technological) will be evaluated through the Curriculum Vitae.
- 7.2. The quality and consistency of the work plan will be evaluated, with a maximum of 03 (three) pages (in English), and must compulsorily include research activities, teaching subjects, courses, training, lectures, or seminars in person.

VIII. RESULTS AND ENROLLMENT

- 8.1. The final result will be published on December 15, 2025, on the IMIP website (www.imip.org.br).
- 8.2. The selected candidate will also be notified by email.
- 8.3. Appeals against the provisional result must be duly justified and submitted within the specified number of business days from the date of its disclosure, exclusively via electronic means. The Examination Committee will analyze appeals within up to 5 (five) business days, and the decision will be final and unappealable.
- 8.4. After the approval announcement, the candidate will have a 15-day period to enroll in the program.
- 8.5. Enrollment in the program will only be effective after the receipt of the duly signed Commitment Agreement(Annex III), which must include the period of activities and the approved period of stay.
- 8.6. In addition to the Commitment Agreement, the selected candidate must sign the Term of Responsibility, Confidentiality, and Adherence to Institutional Norms (Annex IV), declaring awareness and agreement with IMIP's internal norms, applicable legislation (including data protection LGPD), the Code of Conduct, and the IMIP Compliance Program.

X. OBLIGATIONS

The Visiting Professor must:

- 10.1. Provide for obtaining an entry visa to Brazil with validity compatible with the period of stay in Brazil.
- 10.2. Deliver in-person and virtual lectures/seminars (when applicable to the work plan) on scientific topics related to the research lines of IMIP's *stricto sensu* Graduate Program in Integral Health.
- 10.3. Develop 2 (two) intellectual production works (original research, review article) in co-authorship with IMIP researchers, making reference to IMIP's support.
- 10.4. Co-develop with an IMIP researcher a research project, in English, including a detailed budget, schedule, and strategy for submission to funding agencies.
- 10.5. Teach a short course with a workload between 20 and 40 hours, in person at IMIP, on a topic in their field of study.
- 10.6. Submit an activity report developed in Brazil, signed by the Graduate Program Coordinator, up to 30 days after the end of activities.

XI. FINAL PROVISIONS

- **11.1** Failure to comply with any of the requirements specified in this Call resulting from the judgment made by the selection committee will result in the **automatic disqualification** of the proposal.
- **11.2** Omissions in this Call will be decided by the Selection Committee and, if necessary, by the Board of the Integrated Health Graduate Program at IMIP, in light of the legislation in force.



11.3 This Call will come into effect on the date of its publication.
